Motion was made by Rowbotham, seconded by Lundquist to approve the Finance Officer to make monthly payments for utilities, insurance, benefits, fuel, etc prior to council approval. All in favor—Carried.

Motion was made by Rowbotham, seconded by Lundquist to adopt Resolution #2590 as follows:

## RESOLUTION #2590

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Retail Off Sale Liquor Operating Agreement with the Handi Mart LLC located at Replat of OL Z; RR Lot 2, FPG Lots A & B, Original RR Lots in the City of Arlington, Kingsbury County, South Dakota be issued for a three (3) year lease effective January 2, 2020, and that this license shall cost \$600.00 per year and an 11% markup on all wines and liquors which must be purchased through the City. All in favor—Carried.

Time for Public Comments: None.

The Finance Officer furnished the council members with a copy of the Electric Report showing the usage and revenue by categories for the year of 2019. The Mayor gave a short update on the bills that have been brought to the floor in Pierre regarding the electric agreements between the municipals and the rural electrics.

ACDC Report—tabled for executive session regarding contracts.

Motion was made by Johnson, seconded by Achterberg to approve the Employee Overtime, Library and Police Reports. All in favor—Carried.

Motion was made by Johnson, seconded by Falconer to remove Jennifer Dilley from the Arlington Ambulance Service. All in favor—Carried.

The council reviewed the Revenue/Expense, Cash and Utility Reports.

Motion was made by Lundquist, seconded by Achterberg to have the finance officer advertise for sealed bids/quotes for the Crack Sealing and Seal Coating Projects for this summer which will be opened at the March 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting. All in favor—Carried.

Jesse Steffensen now present.

Tammy Anderson, Kingsbury County Director of Equalization, met with the council and furnished them with the information for the local board and the dates that must be followed by the City. She advised that her office did not do any appraisal updates on any classes of property this past year. Commercial property reviews were pushed back to 2020. However, Arlington did have a huge amount of growth in the past year.

The following items were presented to the city council: Municipal Govt Day—Feb 4<sup>th</sup> (Mayor, Jesse and Garth attending), election petitions must be filed by Feb 28<sup>th</sup>; letters will be sent to the area township officers inviting them to attend the March 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting, Local Board of Equalization Meeting will be held March 16<sup>th</sup>, SDML District 2 meeting in Elkton-March 18<sup>th</sup>, and advertise for painters and pool workers for the summer.

Motion was made by Achterberg seconded by Johnson to enter into executive session at 7:40 P.M. for contract matters. All in favor—Carried.

Motion was made by Achterberg, seconded by Lundquist to come out of executive session at 8:30 P.M. All in favor—Carried. No action taken at this time.

Motion to adjourn was made by Rowbotham seconded by Johnson. All in favor—Carried.
