Several of the businesses in the Arlington area were approached about purchasing signs to advertise their business on the outfield fence of the ball field and then pay an annual fee to continue to have the sign in that location. Currently there are 38 businesses who have showed interest in participating in the project. The funds that are raised will be used for improvements at the ballpark. The first priority is to construct a building to replace the current concession stand, bathrooms and equipment room.

Motion was made by Achterberg, seconded by Mutziger to approve moving forward with the advertising signs project. The signs will be 4 x 8 and cost \$300. All in favor—Carried.

Plans for the blueprint of the building along with the type of materials to be used to construct the structure will be researched now that the project will be moving forward.
