The City Council met in special session in the Municipal Building. Present on Roll Call were Mayor Curt Lundquist and Council Members: Terry Rowbotham, Garth Johnson, Beth Sundberg, Sue Falconer & Gary Kaufmann. Absent: Rob Achterberg. Motion by Sundberg, seconded by Kaufmann to approve Resolution 2025-1 Canvass of the City Election Results. Tom Bacon received the majority of votes over Gary Kaufmann 54 votes to 43 votes in the election held on April 8, 2025. All in favor – Motion Carried.
